
Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 14.7% since 2018, growing by 23,731. Population is expected to increase by 10.7% between 2023 and 2028, adding 19,775.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 15.3% in Coeur d'Alene, ID from 70,743 to 81,595. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.5% by 10.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.4% to 60.2% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.7% of Coeur d'Alene**, **ID residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.4% below the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Coeur d'Alene, ID had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.03%, increasing from 3.54% 5 years before.


Millennials

Coeur d'Alene, ID has 35,352 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 37,591.




Veterans

Coeur d'Alene, ID has 13,999 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 9,371.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Coeur d'Alene, ID. The national average for an area this size is 55,850 people 55 or older, while there are 61,617 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Coeur d'Alene, ID. The national average for an area this size is 77,051 racially diverse people, while there are 20,469 here.




Property Crime




Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration











